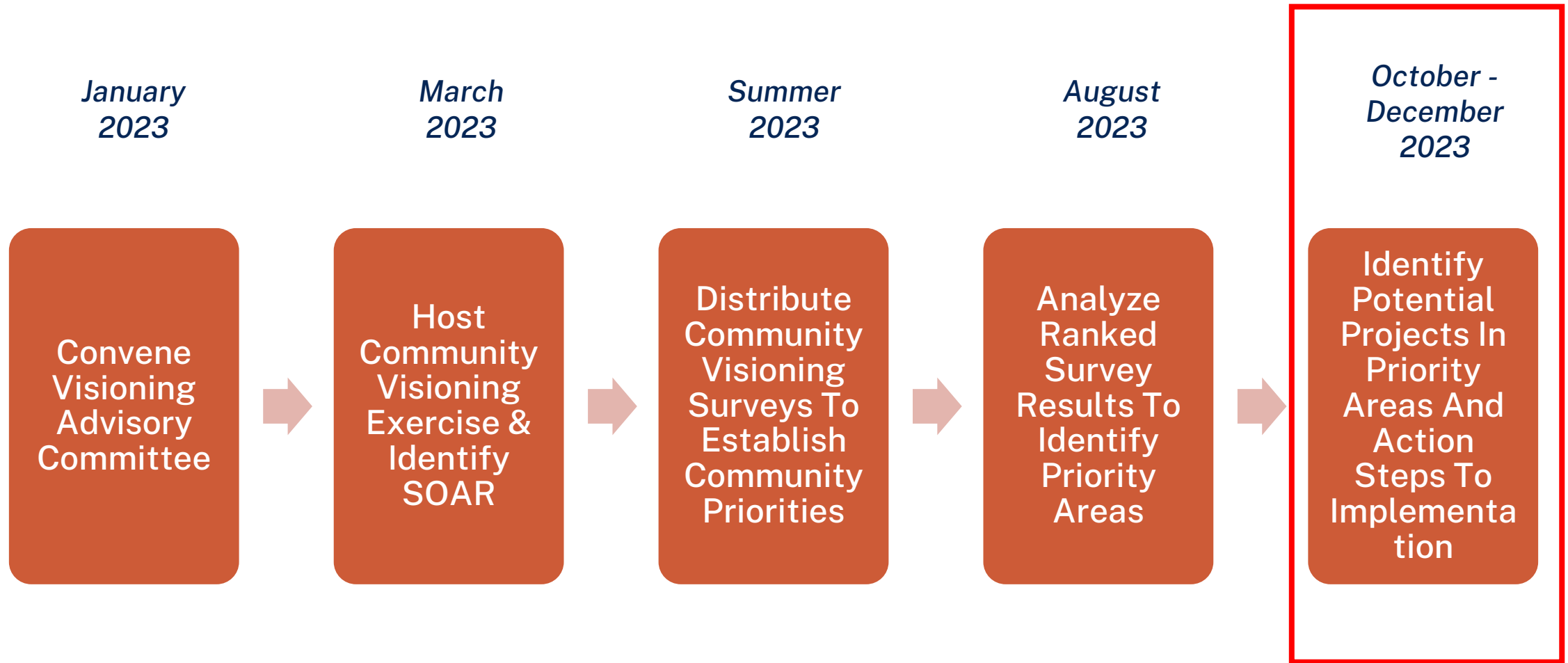




York's Community Visioning Survey Results

Visioning Process

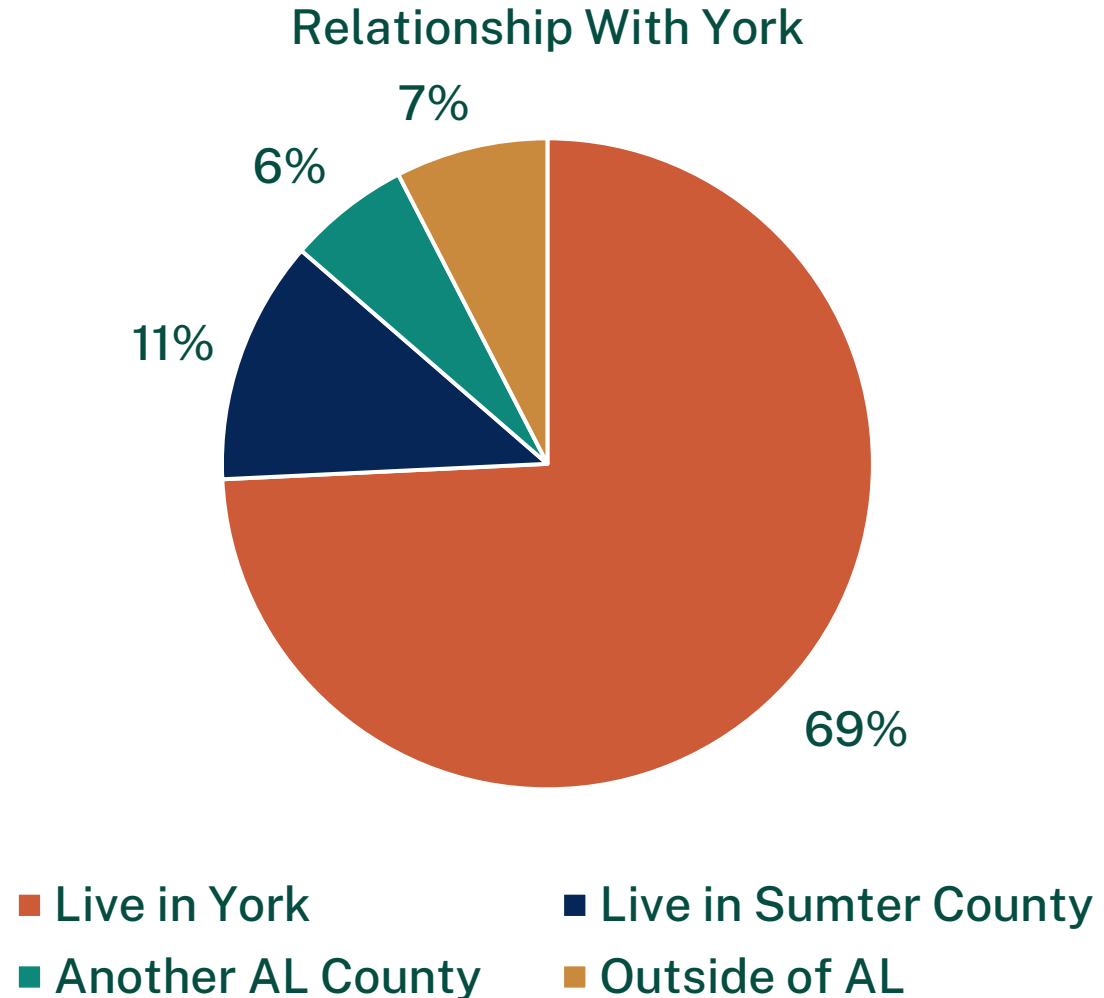


What was being ranked?

- York needs more local job opportunities and workforce training
- York needs to maintain our hospital and improve access to telemedicine
- York needs to keep and attract local businesses, like a grocery store, drug store, and other places for shopping and entertainment
- York needs broadband internet for workers, students, and city services
- York needs better roads and utilities, including improved pedestrian and road access to bypass the railroad crossings
- York needs more affordable housing and housing repair programs
- York needs more services for children and their families, including affordable childcare, activity centers, and afterschool and summer programs
- York needs recreation, including parks and spaces for senior and youth programs
- York needs services for seniors, including assisted living services, senior housing, and senior activities
- York needs a weather siren and storm shelters

Who responded to the visioning survey?

- Open from May 1, 2023 until July 14, 2023 (2.5 months)
- 71 total respondents
 - 49 responded on paper
 - 22 responded to the virtual survey
- Responses were ranked by their cumulative scores



How did the community respond?



Local Economy & Healthcare

- 1) York needs more local job opportunities and workforce training (159)
- 2) York needs to maintain our hospital and improve access to telemedicine (160)
- 3) York needs to keep and attract local businesses, like a grocery store, drug store, and other places for shopping and entertainment (186)



Infrastructure

- 4) York needs broadband internet for workers, students, and city services (238)
- 5) York needs better roads and utilities, including improved pedestrian and road access to bypass the railroad crossings (241)

How did they respond?



Housing, Recreation, & Services

- 6) York needs more affordable housing and housing repair programs (323)
- 7) York needs more services for children and their families, including affordable childcare, activity centers, and afterschool and summer programs (339)
- 8) York needs recreation, including parks and spaces for senior and youth programs (346)
- 9) York needs services for seniors, including assisted living services, senior housing, and senior activities (360)
- 10) York needs a weather siren and storm shelters (372)
